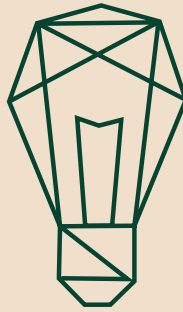

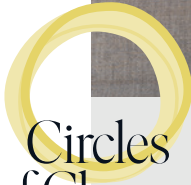

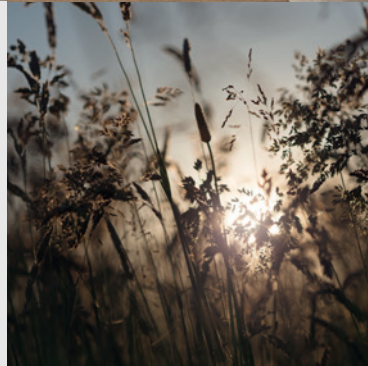
RT HON SIR ALOK SHARMA KCMG MEMBER OF PARLIAMENT

Elected as an MP in 2010, Alok previously worked in investment banking based out of London, Frankfurt and Stockholm. He has served in a range of ministerial positions and was appointed President Designate of the 26th UN Climate Change Conference (COP26) in 2020, alongside his role as Secretary of State for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy. In 2021 he took on the COP26 role full-time, leading the UK's work in bringing together the world to tackle climate change and getting almost 200 countries to sign-up to the historic Glasgow Climate Pact. Alok was knighted in the 2023 New Year's honours for services to tackling climate change.
